History of Tokyo SME University

- 1962 ●Establishment of the Japan Small and Medium Enterprise Advisory Center (in Yotsuya, Shinjuku-ku)
- Start of 3 courses: SME Management Consultant (Shindanshi) training program (commerce and industry), Technical Advisor training program, and SME Advisor training program
- 1964 ●Beginning of training for SME support organization staff
- 1965 ●Completion of advanced technical training center (Research Bldg. 2) and Murasaki Dormitory in Fuchu, Tokyo
- 1966 ●Beginning of training for SME technicians / short term case studies
- 1967 ●Management training starts in Yotsuya, technical training in Fuchu
- Beginning of management training for staff in charge of SME measures
- 1969 ●Beginning of training for business executives
- 1971 ●Completion of SME training center main building (Research Bldg. 1) and Murasaki Dormitory II in Fuchu, Tokyo
- 1972 ●Beginning of Management Training and Technical Training in Fuchu
- 1973 ●Beginning of correspondence training programs
- 1977 ●Completion of Research Bldg. 3 in Fuchu-shi and Higashi-Yamato Dormitory in Higashi-Yamato, Tokyo
- 1980 ●Beginning of training for business successors and for managers
- 1986 ●Beginning of Information course, added to the SME Management Consultant (Shindanshi) program
- 1995 ●Beginning of training for start-up support
- 1998 ●Beginning of Town Manager training course
- 1999 ●Completion of a new campus in Higashi-Yamato
- 2000 ●Closure of Murasaki Dormitory due to completion of renovations to Building A of Higashi-Yamato Dormitory (move from Fuchu facilities)
- Beginning of new SME Management Consultant (Shindanshi) programs in accordance with the newly established SME Support Law
- 2001 ●Training categories change from Management Training and Technical Training to Training for SME supporters and Training for SME practitioners
- 2003 ●Beginning of GMC University Web-based Training
