



A Report on Philippine CEO Network Enhancing Project 2016



On December 8th, 2016, together with the Commercial Section of the Philippine Consulate General of Osaka and Overseas Business Promotion Council of Osaka Foundation for Trade & Industry, SME Support, JAPAN co-organized a business meeting event and business seminars on Philippine as part of the CEO Network Enhancing Project in Osaka, Japan. This event invited business owners and decision makers from sectors including automobile and aircraft parts manufacturing, and software related IT companies.

From the Philippines, 14 companies seeking collaboration, production contracts, joint venture, or market expansion with Japanese SMEs arrived in Japan.

During the 1 on 1 business meeting portion of the event, 124 meetings were held with 56 Japanese SMEs. The event pursued match-making with great enthusiasm as additional time for exchanging business cards was allotted by utilizing recess time, specifically for participants who could not sit down to speak to all of their desired companies from the Philippines.

As for the seminar portion of the program, a dignitary from the Philippine government and a company from Osaka, having the experience of entering the Philippine market, provided the country's latest business information including trends in government policy making in the President Duterte era. Over 100 participants gathered and commented favorably by saying, "I gained clarity about the future of Philippine's economy and the growth of local companies", and also that "the input from the company that actually developed business in the Philippines was very helpful".
