What Is Lacquerware?

Lacquerware refers to wooden dishes painted with a thick layer of special coating that comes from tree sap. Made in Japan from natural products, these dishes are safe to use everyday.



Dishes made from lacquerware retain heat, so they're ideal for soups and other hot dishes. You can keep food warm, without the dish becoming too hot. Used every day, they last for a long time too! You'll love using lacquerware in your daily life!




This wine has a mellower, less acidic flavor.
